President Ray opened the meeting at 10:30 with a welcome to all and asked Judy Greene to report on the status of the in-coming Northern Colorado FF club visiting April 20-25, arriving at 6:45, Greensboro airport. She outlined the currently planned events advising of some open tickets available for the production of "Hamilton" at the Tanger Center.

Through Ray, Martha Brown reported upon the Outbound journey to Cincinnati with Charles' additional information. There are hosts available for some additional Ambassadors who might be prospective members. There are currently 7 confirmed. Funds for the journey were approved and shall be sent to Martha.

Charles, board journeys coordinator, spoke about future journeys, including that of Lincoln, Nebraska, June 19-30, 2022 and September 17-24<sup>th</sup> Mary's, Ontario, Canada . Further information will be presented after final planning .

Social events were outlined by Lucy, advising about the options being considered by her committee. Virginia farm outing and Ray and Judy's visit there to further solidify the plans.

The Treasurer's was presented by Laura and was approved, as was the minutes of the prior meeting.

Mary, speaking about the membership, said that there were three new members of the Winston Salem Women's Club who had joined and presented options of two name tags.
