FFCNC's need for effective Communications: What's Up Doc? - As B Bunny used to ask? Well, '<u>WhatsAPP.com'</u> is what is up! I sent an email to my Open World Delegate from Kyrgyzstan. He asked if I used WhatsAPP. I used an early version several years ago briefly when interacting with scientists in Beijing. I reloaded the app and had a neighbor test my WhatsApp connection.

I called my Delegate in his Office in Kyrgyzstan at my 9:00 AM and his 7:00 PM. There is a 10-hour difference. We had a Face-to-Face talk, video/sound. We had a pleasant fruitful introduction. It allowed me to plan about what he hoped to see. He said his particular interest was in how and where we socialize with and meet friends. I plan to expose him to my socializing with friends, most at Church discussion, music, and eating activities, and shopping for sure.

WhatApp uses an encrypted digital signal, and is free with video, voice, email, and text. It has improved. I recently called the Facilitator in DC to see if I could contact my assigned Delegate and determine if he had a phone. I was told that he did have a phone. He was not connected to Verizon, etc. but it could make calls to the group, and some others, because WhatsAPP was installed. It worked whenever he was connected to the internet via wireless. I think WhatsAPP is now used worldwide. It should be very useful for FFI and FFCNC members when involved in travel.

<u>Membership:</u> Eleanor Stoller, our Membership Chair, says we now have 71 members, some moved away, and others have joined. We are ahead. Membership records are used for collecting our small dues, placing information on FFCNC.org web site, and creating the email list.

We are almost done correcting errors and perfecting our procedures.

There are about 20 members who still need to fill out forms and register with FFI.org, the Friendship Force International. Reminders are coming.

Activity of members was slowed during covid times but are now moving ahead. Covid may still be a concern since it is still with

us. With boosters and Paxlovid antiviral, precautions can be safely taken.
